ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

WHITE OAK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. A FLORIDA NOT-FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION

I, the undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, am a natural person, competent to contract and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be WHITE OAK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC., and it shall be a Florida not-for-profit corporation under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statues (2002) as subsequently amended.

ARTICLE II

The initial street address of the principal office of this corporation in the State of Florida is: 1502 N.W. 6th Street, Gainesville, Florida 32601. The initial mailing address of the corporation is 1502 N.W. 6th Street, Gainesville, Florida 32601.

ARTICLE III

The general purposes for which the corporation is organized is to administer certain affairs in the White Oak phased development as stated in the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for White Oak being recorded simultaneously herewith, which administration is more particularly defined as follows:

- (A) to provide maintenance, repair and replacement of Recreational Area and of the fences located in the Landscape Easements;
- (B) prior to the Turnover Date as defined below in Article IX, and subject to the overall approval of the Master Association, to review and approve proposed construction or alterations on any part of the Premises;
- (C) to adopt and enforce restrictions, covenants, rules, regulations and conditions relating to the use of the Recreational Area; and
- (D) to levy and collect assessments from Owners to pay the cost of performing the foregoing.

ARTICLE IV

Except as provided in Article IX below, the method of election or appointment of the directors are as stated in the corporation's By-Laws.

ARTICLE V

The street address of the corporation's initial registered agent and its initial registered office is as follows:

ARTICLE VI

The name and street address of the person signing the Articles of Incorporation as subscriber is as follows:

ARTICLE VII

Each owner of a Unit within the White Oak phased development shall be a member of the Association. There shall be one (1) member per Unit. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of a Unit. Ownership of a Unit shall be the sole qualification for membership unless otherwise provided herein. In the event of a dispute between the Owners of any Unit as to which one holds what membership or voting rights, the Association shall make the final decision.

ARTICLE VIII

Prior to the Turnover Date as defined below in Article IX, all of the voting rights at each meeting of the Association shall be vested exclusively in the Developer and the Owners shall have no voting rights. After the Turnover Date, the Members shall have one (1) vote per Unit.

ARTICLE IX

The first and all subsequent Association Boards shall consist solely of one (1) to three (3) persons from time to time designated by the Developer, White Oak, LLC, which persons may, but need not, be members of the Association. Developer's rights under this Article to designate the Members of the Association Board shall terminate on the first to occur of:

- a) The giving of written notice by Developer to the Association and all Owners of Developer's election to terminate such rights; or
- b) Three (3) months after ninety percent (90%) of the parcels in all phases of the Development that will ultimately be operated by the Association have been conveyed to members other than the Developer. For purposes of this provision, the phrase "members other than the Developer" shall not include builders, contractors or others who purchase a parcel for the purpose of constructing improvements thereon for resale.

The date on which the Developer's rights under this Section shall terminate shall be referred to as the "Turnover Date". From and after the Turnover Date, the Association Board shall consist of from three (3) to five (5) members and shall be constituted and elected as provided in the By-Laws. Prior to the Turnover Date all of the voting rights at any meeting of the Owners shall be vested exclusively in the Developer, and the Members shall have no voting rights.

ARTICLE X

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any manner provided by law.

ARTICLE XI

This corporation shall have perpetual existence and shall commence its corporate existence on the date these Articles of Incorporation are filed with the Department of State.
